KYOTO IMPERIAL PALACE

Must visit! 5 mins walk from Noku Kyoto to Kyoto Imperial Palace. This historic marvel, located amidst beautifully landscaped gardens, embodies grace and grandeur.

KYOTO INTERNATIONAL MANGA MUSEUM

Housed in a former elementary school built in 1929, the Kyoto International Manga Museum is heaven for lovers of Japanese comic books!

GOOU JINJA ≡SHRINE≡

Surrounded by figures of wild boars, this shrine is frequented by people who come to pray for health, especially for recovery from lower body injuries

Built, in the early 17th century, Nijo Castle is a historical masterpiece that tells the story of Japan's rich heritage. It's a stunning example of Edo period architecture.
